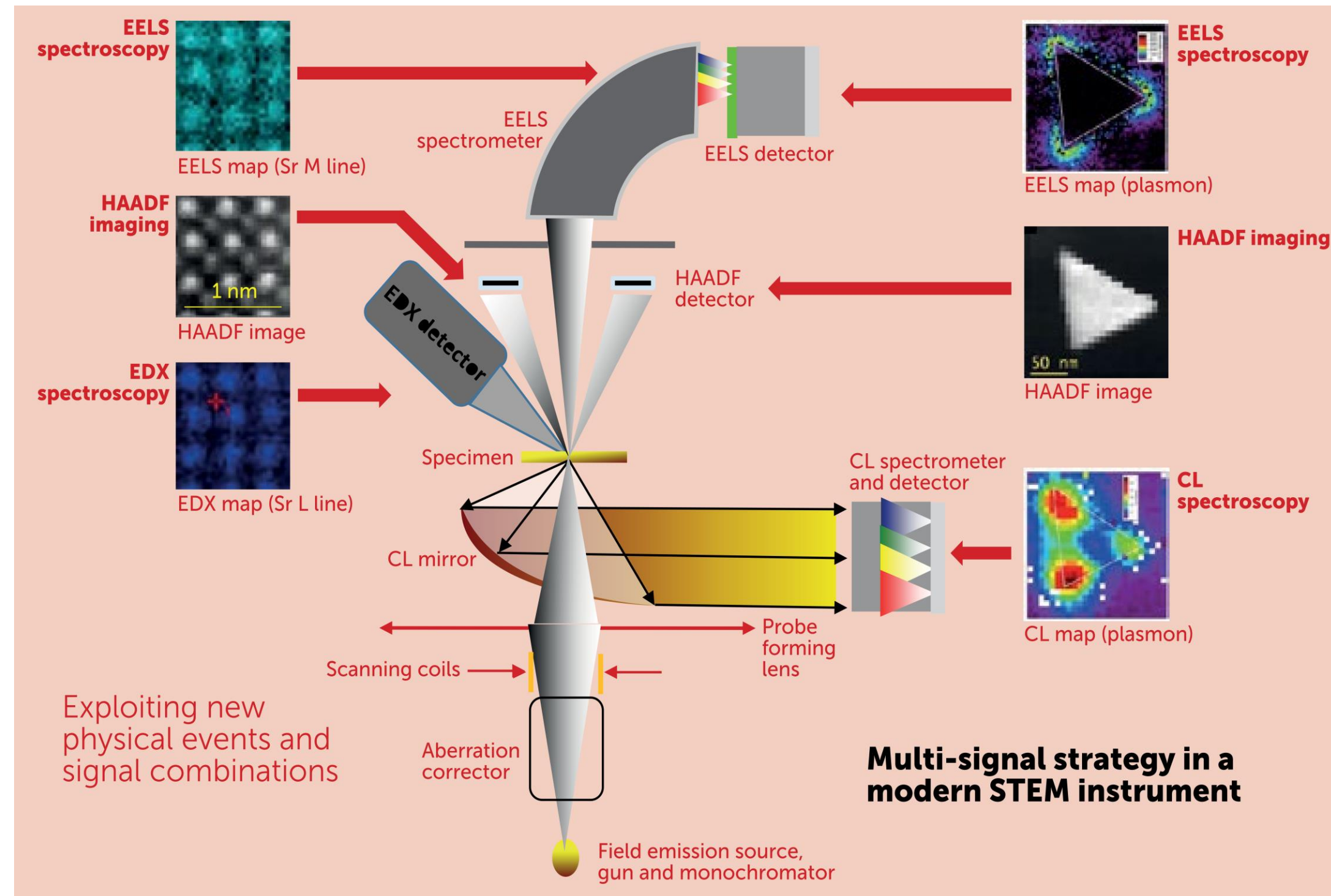

He graduated from the École Nationale Supérieure des Mines de Paris in 1965 and received his PhD in Physics from the Faculté des Sciences d'Orsay in 1970 at the Laboratoire de Physique des Solides (LPS), Orsay, France. As a CNRS staff member, from Attaché de Recherches in 1965 to Directeur de Recherches at his retirement, he has spent his entire career, apart from short periods, at LPS. He was Head of the Electron Microscopy group until 2009, and from 2007 to 2010 served as President of the International Federation of the Societies for Microscopy (IFSM). He is currently CNRS Emeritus Research Director.
